

## **VIKING SPORTSMEN WALLEYE STOCKING PROGRAM PROCEDURE & CHECKLIST FOR PRIVATE STOCKING**

Lake associations and sportsmen's clubs can take advantage of up to a \$500 contribution from the Viking Sportsmen Club by following the check list below. Funds are limited and based on dated receipt of the (1)**Request for Fish Stocking Funds** form, (2)copy of **stocking permit**, and (3)copy of **receipt** from fish stocker.

- Lake association makes a financial commitment for stocking their lake. Viking Sportsmen's Club will give a \$500 contribution to the Lake Association for any stocking above \$1,000 and pay half of the cost for any amount under \$1,000.
- Choose a fish stocker that fits your needs for price and availability of walleye fingerlings. Find out the **number of pounds and fish per pound** that can be stocked for your budget (This number will be important in the next step).

- Contact Dean Beck at DNR Area Fisheries Office in Glenwood (320-634-7323) to determine if the supplemental stocking fits into the management plan for your lake. Dean will need the **number of pounds and fish per pound** info from the fish stocker to approve, modify, or deny stocking request. Modifying or denying could change or nullify the Viking Sportsmen Club contribution.
- Mail **REQUEST FOR FISH STOCKING FUNDS** form to Viking Sportsmen Club.
- Complete the **LIVE FISH TRANSPORTATION IMPORTATION AND STOCKING PERMIT** with your fish stocker. Much of the information on the permit will need input from the stocker. Scan and email this permit to Henry Drewes (henry.drewes@state.mn.us) at the DNR regional office for final approval. The DNR will approve the stocker to fill the order.
- Your lake association representative or sportsmen club member should be on site to confirm the stocking. The stocker will complete the bottom portion of the form and give a receipt to the lake association. The association will submit the completed permit to Henry Drewes at DNR Regional Office in Bemidji **within 72 hours after stocking**.
- Lake association submits a copy of the receipt and stocking permit to the Viking Sportsmen Club for the contribution.
